<u>Please note that this will be the only pre-event fundraiser replacing the individual class pre-parties and Raise the</u> <u>Paddle. So dig deep, give big, and let's have some fun with this friendly contest!</u>

THE RULES:

- 1. Nominee must be a parent who has a child currently attending St. Cecilia School. The nominees do not need to be a couple, but can be individual mothers, fathers, or guardians. Nominees must attend the Spring Fundraiser Event on April 4, 2020.
- 2. One nomination ballot submission per family (but can include both a king and queen nomination).
- 3. Parents with multiple children in different grades must select the grade they want to represent.
- 4. There will be several elimination rounds; each round will commence 2 weeks after the beginning of each round. Nominees will proceed based on the amount of pledges that are received for each nominee. The Committee Co-Chairs will determine the eliminations based on pledge amounts. The details of the individual pledge amounts will not be open to the public but grade progress will be posted on-line.
- 5. You do not have to pledge votes to a specific nominee, instead you have the option to give a monetary donation to the GRADE of your choice to boost the GRADE's chances of securing one of the three grand rewards.
- 6. The winning GRADE with the highest pledges be announced March 30, 2020.
- 7. The Prom King and Queen final voting round will take place at the event with live voting closing at 8pm.
- 8. There will be 6 winners for the evening: King and Queen, Prince and Princess, and Dutch and Duchess. These 6 members of the royal court will be determined by1st, 2nd, and 3rd highest pledges received during the event evening.
